ILCA Dinghy master's Guidelines- Single Handed Class

ELIGIBILITY & AGE DIVISIONS

Master's events are restricted to competitors ages 30 and older. The competitor's age on the regatta start date determines the group the sailor competes in for the whole regatta. Age divisions are as follows:

- 30-44: Apprentice (effective January 1, 2022)
- 45-54: Master
- 55-64: Grand Master
- 65-74: Great Grand Master
- 75 +: Legend

There will be two Divisions starting and scored separately. The ILCA 7 Class and the ILCA 6 class.

PHRF Double Handed Masters' Guidelines- Double Handed Class

ELIGIBILITY & AGE DIVISIONS

To be eligible to compete in the Double Handed Class, each registrant must be 35 years of age or older. There will be no Sub Class scoring for the Double Handed Masters' Class.

International Lightning Class Master's Guidelines- Triple Handed Class

ELIGIBILITY & AGE DIVISIONS

For Masters' Championship: Minimum age of skipper is 55 years; minimum total crew age is 130 years. The skipper and crew meet the minimum age requirements if the age(s) is reached during the calendar year of the Championship.

Proposed Change to the International Lightning Class Rules has been approved-

Skippers and crew age 35 years of age or older will be allowed to enter and compete in the 2024 International Pan American Masters Games. There will be a sub class scored separately following the International Lightning Class Masters' Ruling/guideline of; For Masters' Championship: Minimum age of skipper is 55 years; minimum total crew age is 130 years. The skipper and crew meet the minimum age requirements if the age(s) is reached during the calendar year of the Championship.

Scoring

Scoring will follow each specific Class Rules and Guidelines.

Single Handed Age Divisions- ILCA Dinghy

- 30-44: Apprentice (effective January 1, 2022)
- 45-54: Master
- 55-64: Grand Master
- 65-74: Great Grand Master
- 75 +: Legend

Single Handed Rig Size Divisions- ILCA Dinghy

- ILCA-7- Full Rig
- ILCA-6 Radial Rig

Awards for the ILCA Dinghy will be awarded for the top three competitors of each age Division, as well as each rig size division.

Double Handed-PHRF Double Handed Class

- 35 years of age or older
- Divisions will be made by Handi-cap fleet splits following the local PHRF rules.

Awards will be given to the top three teams in each Hand-cap division.

Triple Handed-International Lightning Class

- Skipper Age 35 and above- Masters' Open division
- Skipper age 55 and Total crew age equal to or more than 130 years of age in total- International Lightning Class Master Division

Both Divisions will sail as one fleet on the same course.

Awards for the International Lightning Class will be awarded for the top three teams in each age division.
